THE DEATH PENALTY IN HARRIS COUNTY

As Texas moves away from the death penalty, Harris County remains an outlier.

HARRIS COUNTY REMAINS A TOP SENTENCING COUNTY

Although death sentences in Harris County have dropped significantly in recent years-with juries imposing just three new death verdicts since 2017-it remains the state's top sentencing county.

imprisonment, is the most **appropriate punishment** for murder, according to a 2020 survey conducted by the Kinder Institue for Urban Research at Rice University.
